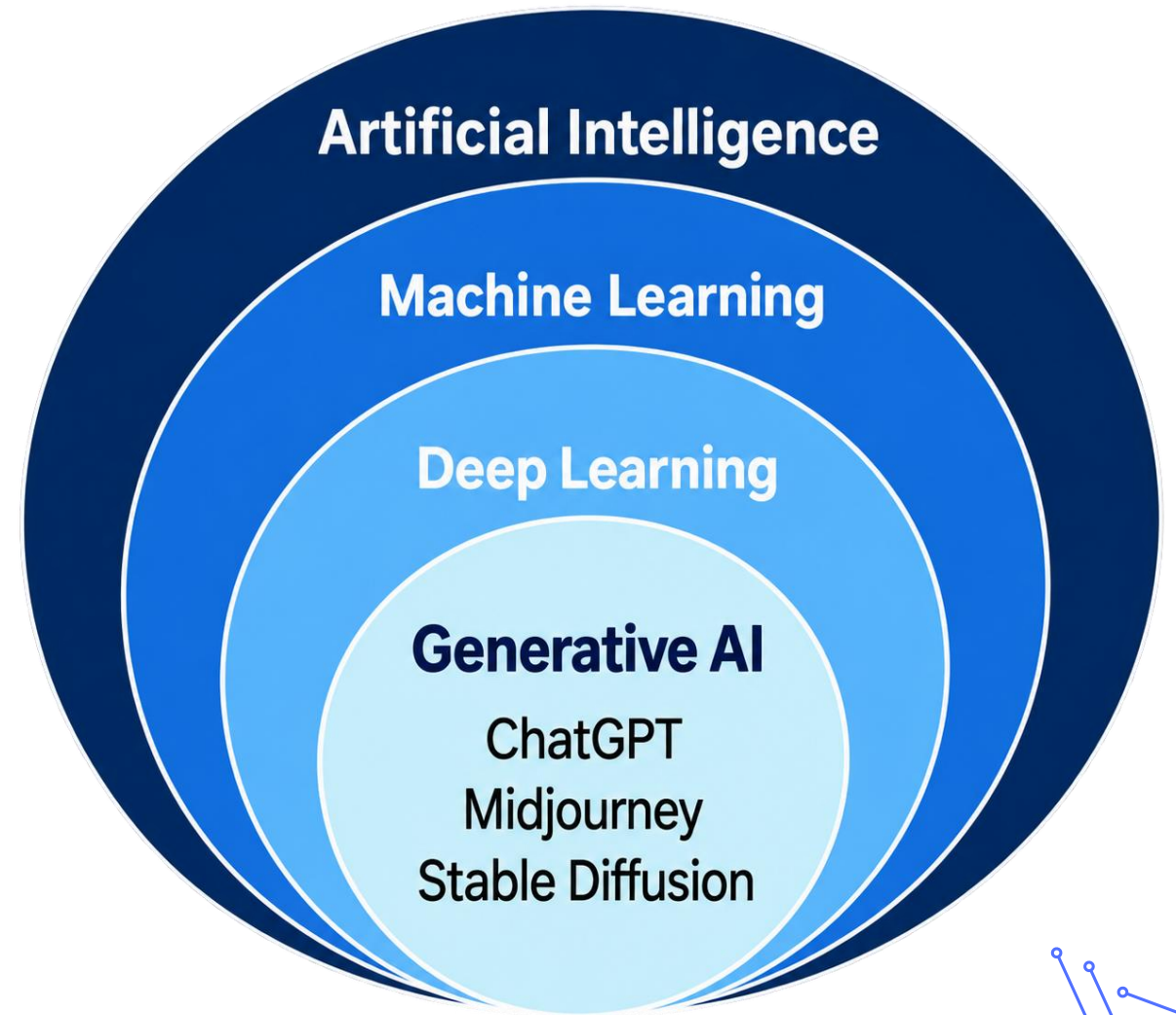
WHAT IS Artificial Intelligence?

Imagine computers that can learn, think, and adapt like humans.

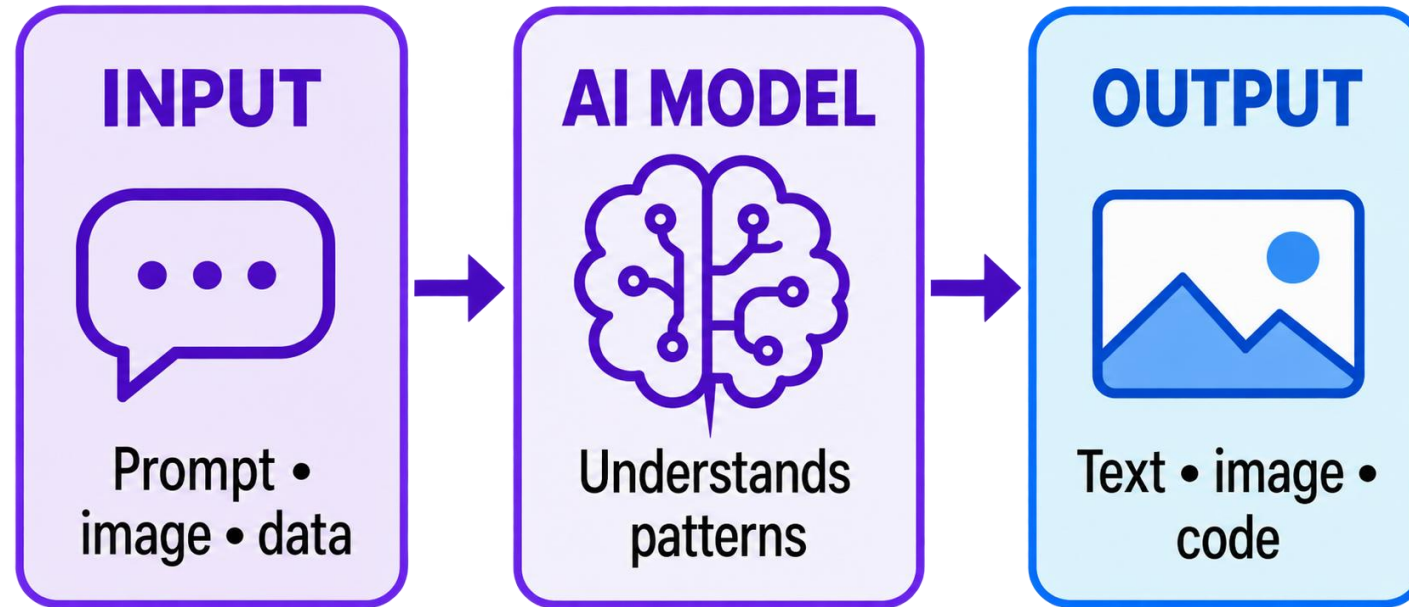

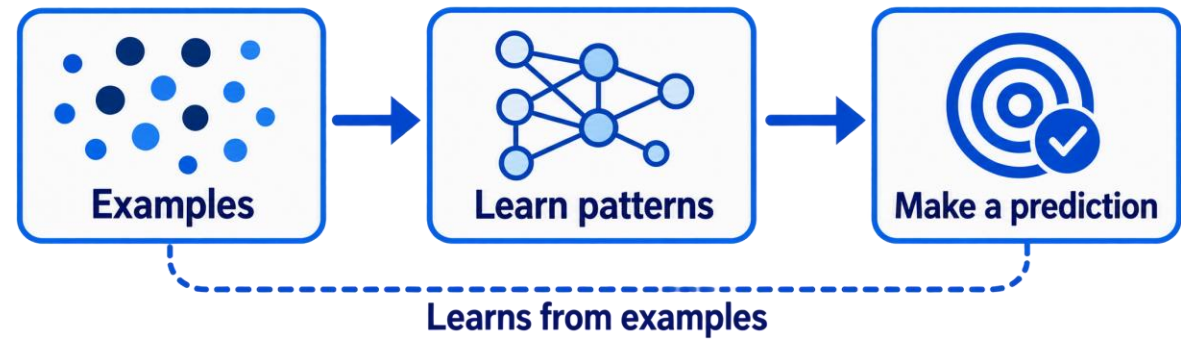

ANTHROPIC BIOSECURITY REPORT – DUAL – USE CONTROL

A disclosure of suspected dual-use research and access-control evasion. The provider explicitly did not establish harmful intent, name a country, or report a confirmed biological weapon.



Legitimate Science

Vaccine development, disease surveillance, and public health research.



The Dual – Use Overlap

Knowledge that can serve both therapeutic goals and harmful development. Intent is often uncertain.



Harmful Misuse

Development of biological weapons or precursors.



OLD RISKS NEW TOOLS

Fraud, manipulation, impersonation and misinformation have been around for years. **AI didn't create these risks, it changed what's possible.**

New Mexico lawyer fined for using AI-generated brief containing fabricated testimony

- New Mexico defense attorney **Stephen Aarons** used ChatGPT to summarize trial records for a murder appeal.
- ChatGPT **invented police testimony and fabricated witnesses** that were never part of the trial record.
- The AI-generated summary also **incorrectly represented key facts** about the case.
- Aarons relied on the information **without properly verifying it** against the original records.

The New Mexico Supreme Court **held Aarons in contempt and fined him \$5,000.**
